MARCELLO CORMIO

Music Director & Conductor

Marcello Cormio begins his fourth season as Music Director of the Central Kentucky Youth Orchestras. Mr. Cormio has worked as a conductor, opera coach, pianist and educator, both in Europe and in the USA. Outside of his work at CKYO, he continues to be very active as both a symphonic and operatic conductor.

Among his recent engagements, Mr. Cormio conducted the Winter 2018 Tour of the "Irish Tenors" in December 2018 and conducted a double bill of Donizetti and Wolff-Ferrari for Sarasota Opera's 2019 Season.

South Florida Classical praised him as "an assured hand in the pit, conducting the score with vitality while leaving the singers room to breathe in their solos" for *Così fan tutte* at Sarasota Opera's 2016 season. Mr. Cormio's "notable" conducting debut at the 2014 Sarasota

Opera Festival in *Il barbiere di Siviglia* was praised for a "lovely, light touch with the music": "the young Italian drew vital and spirited playing, with the fizzing ensemble exciting yet with a fine balancing of solo voices, chorus and orchestra" (The Classical Review).

He has led productions of *L'elisir d'amore*, *Così fan tutte* and *A Room with a View* at the Michigan State University, *Street Scene* at the West Virginia University, *Le nozze di Figaro* at the 2015 Sarasota Opera Festival, and *Hansel and Gretel* at Savannah Voice Festival.

As a symphonic conductor, he has appeared with orchestras around the United States and Europe, including the San Antonio Symphony, the Orchestra della Società dei Concerti di Bari, the Orchestra Sinfonica della Città Metropolitana di Bari, the Bacau Symphony, and the Orchestra Sinfonica del Conservatorio di Bari; he has also served as cover conductor for the Pittsburgh Symphony Orchestra during the 2014-2015 season.

Mr. Cormio was music director and conductor of opera scenes productions at the Manhattan School of Music in New York, and at the Indiana University School of Music. In 2013 he was cover and assistant conductor for a new production of *Turandot* at the Opéra National de Lorraine in Nancy, France. Mr. Cormio has led productions of *Die Zauberflöte* at the Bay View Music Festival, and of Gounod's *Roméo et Juliette* and *The Phantom of the Opera* with the University of Kentucky Opera Theatre.

Mr. Cormio has been active as an opera coach and educator throughout his career. He is regularly invited as coach and conductor for opera workshops at prestigious academic institutions, and in summer music festivals, such as *Opera do Recife* (Brazil) and *Prague Summer Nights* (Czech Republic). In the year 2014-15 he was on faculty at the West Virginia University as Head of the Opera Program.

He is currently on the faculty of the University of Kentucky as Director of the University of Kentucky Philharmonia and is the Artistic Director of the *Opera Lucca Festival* in Lucca, Italy.

Mr. Cormio holds graduate degrees in piano, composition, conducting, and musicology from Italian conservatories and universities, as well as a Master of Music degree from Indiana University and a Doctor of Musical Arts degree from the University of Kentucky.



NANCY CAMPBELL

Conductor

Nancy Campbell serves as the Orchestra Director at the School for Creative and Performing Arts (SCAPA) and is an Instrumental Music Faculty member for the Kentucky Center for the Performing Arts Governor's School for the Arts.

Mrs. Campbell has served as President, Secretary/Treasurer and Membership Chair of Kentucky Chapter of the American String Teachers Association, Inc. and is Past Orchestra Chair for the Kentucky Music Educators Association. In 2010, she was the recipient of both the KMEA Middle School Teacher of the Year



Award and KYASTA Distinguished Service Award. Additionally, she is the cofounder of L.O.V.E. (Lexington's Original Viola Ensemble) and performs as an extra violist with the Lexington Philharmonic.

For her creative teaching practices, Mrs. Campbell was named Yamaha Certified String Educator, which recognizes string teachers using innovative ideas and pushing the boundaries of string education. She has articles published with the American String Teachers Journal and the D'addario Education Collective.

She received her Bachelor of Music Education from Northern Illinois University and completed her Master of Arts in Education and Rank I Music certification at the University of Kentucky.

CKYO established the Friends in Music (FIM) program in 1996. CKYO high school string members act as mentors alongside the Program Director and professional teachers to teach free stringed instrument lessons to middle schoolers in Title I schools in Fayette County. FIM currently operates in two Fayette County middle schools; Bryan Station Middle School and Leestown Middle School. For the 2020 Fall, our meetings have taken place virtually via Zoom each week and we have almost 90 student participants and over 50 high school mentors!

CKYO MusicWorks is an after-school orchestral and ensemble music program fostering positive development of Lexington's youth by providing equitable access to high-quality music

education. At MusicWorks, we believe that every child has the right to a high quality musical education. We strive to eliminate traditional access barriers by providing instruction and resources at no cost to participants in exchange for their full commitment to the program. To adapt this fall, the program participants have been split into small groups (5-8 students) and come once a week for in-person instruction. Additional lessons and group work is offered virtually.

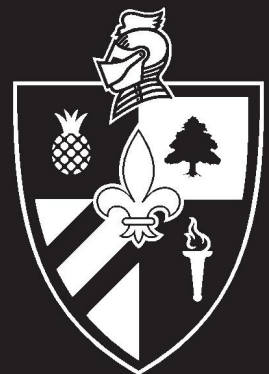
